The Agency operates a Windows Server Enterprise Edition network with three dedicated servers. The Agency network includes approximately 9,000 client computers at nearly 200 physical locations with as few as 2-3 computers and as many as 500 computers per site.

## Working with Employees

Although they do not disclose the name of the software, the Agency makes it clear that computer activity and Internet use is monitored. Employees are required to acknowledge an Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) when they sign on to a computer.

"When users boot up, there is a login notice stating that the computer is subject to monitoring. It's made clear that there is a risk associated with inappropriate use of company assets, including dismissal."

The agency describes various parts of its AUP at login, such as downloading prohibited files and programs, use of properly licensed software, and the computer and Agency information is to be used for professional purposes only. Veriato 360 is an integral part of that policy, monitoring each computer, immediately notifying Administrators of inappropriate use or theft of intellectual property.
